- Improve the capacity of stakeholders to integrate environment and climate considerations in infrastructure policies, design and implementation.
- Aggregate and analyse data to provide empirical evidence to support furthering the environmental sustainability agenda in infrastructure.
- Commit to support the climate finance agenda and supports its reform policies.

### At the corporate level

- Work to understand the sources of our resource impact and green-house gas emissions.
- Ensure we work closely with clients, suppliers, and other stakeholders to continually improve our business processes to minimise our impact on the environment.
- Undertake responsible resource management practices that aim to prevent pollution and reduce waste through digital distribution, limiting the consumption of consumables, engaging in recycling programs, utilising power and water-saving devices, investing in office plants to reduce stress and improve air quality and encouraging staff to commute to work in carbon-neutral ways.
- Foster the initiation and ownership of environmental activities by all our staff through education, thereby building a strong, environmentally aware business culture.
- Set environmental targets and objectives and monitor for improvement.
- Measure the impact of our initiatives on environmental factors.

#### **Performance measurement**

- Address environmental issues in the review of the organisation's corporate plan, including its operations and activities, and integrate environmental considerations in the development of the annual business plan and reporting through annual and impact reports, which are subject to approval by the governance bodies.
- Ensure that the GI Hub's strategic and business planning and projects include a lens of environmental sustainability so that our work program reflects our commitments in this area and our impact is captured in our reporting.

Map the GI Hub's internal environmental impacts and identify potential opportunities for reduction

Coordinate at least one activity or initiative for staff that promotes environmental sustainability

Map and report environmental sustainability targets/progress in the annual report, impact report, and Board reports

Policies and commitments are reviewed annually to ensure that they meet our objectives and that they are fit for purpose.
